FEATURES

- Soft and comfortable cover that can be removed and washed. (Instructions under “Important Notes”)
- Straps to attach a regular collar to.
- Plastic clip and buckle for adjusting tightness.
- Regular strap instead of velcro, so it does not get stuck everywhere.
- Possibility to choose, how full of air and how tight the collar is.
- Great looking colour scheme.

Attention! This product does not guarantee 100% access restriction. Depending on the size and flexibility of your dog and the placement of the injury, the collar may or may not be of help. Before you start using it on your dog, you need to test it to be sure, that it prevents your dog from reaching the places they do not need to. Look for the testing instructions under “Important Notes”.

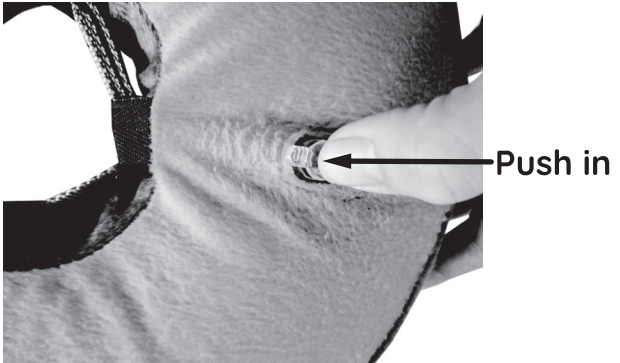
HOW TO USE THE NECK DONUT?

For maximum performance, you have to attach your dog's regular collar to the inflatable collar.

1. Put your dog's regular collar through the straps on the inner circle of the inflatable collar. Make sure, that the buckle of the regular collar stays near the open part of the inflatable collar.



2. Close the zipper and inflate the collar via the valve (pinch and blow). Do not inflate it to the limit, but do not leave it half-empty, either. Then, close the valve and push it inside.



3. Position the open part of the inflatable collar towards the back side of your dog's head to prevent chewing of the strap or getting paws stuck there.



4. Put both of the collars together on your pet's neck. First, fasten the regular collar, then fasten the inflatable one and tighten it from the buckles.

After putting the collar on, the first reaction of your pet may be to freeze, hide or scratch it off.

You may need to help your pet to get used to it by encouraging with treats or toys.

You can learn more about it in our training guide that is included in the package.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- **Test it before use!**

You can test how your dog reaches off-limits areas by putting treats that your pet prefers, for an example, peanut butter, on their front paws, back paws or their behind. If your dog reaches the peanut butter while wearing the inflatable collar, then it is either too small or needs to be tightened more and used together with a regular collar.

- **Keep the other pets at bay!**

If your dog is in a multi-pet household, the other pets may have to be kept away from the injured dog so that they do not lick the wounds.

- **Leave the collar on at all times!**

There is really no reason to take it off, because your pet can eat, drink and sleep with it on. The more consistent you are, the faster they will become accustomed to the collar.

- **Clean the inflatable collar often!**

The only important reason to take the collar off is to wash it. You can open the zipper, take the inside part out and wash the cover. We recommend a delicate hand wash of the outer cover in water not hotter than 30 °C . Do not tumble-dry it. While washing the collar, your pet must be watched closely so that no damage can be done to the wound.

- **DO NOT USE THIS AS A FLOTATION DEVICE!**

GOOD TO KNOW

- There is a chance that dogs might chew on the collar or claw it and it deflates. Keep an eye on them and do not allow your dog to bite the collar! If your dogs are uncontrollable chewers, then they will probably manage to break it.
- Some dogs with longer limbs may still reach their paws or wounds. Because of that, this collar suits better for keeping dogs away from their upper body or behind.
- If you go from a warm environment to a cold one, the inflatable collar shrinks quite significantly. Do note, that if you fill the collar with air in a cold environment and you go into a warm environment, the air inside will expand and if the collar is full of air to the brim, it may rupture.
- The collar does not scrape your furniture, but your dog might still bump into things, because the collar is wider than your pet's body. Remove any items from your dog's regular paths that are sharp or can fall over when pushed.
